

## ST. STEPHEN'S JUNIOR SCHOOL

### MOBILE PHONE POLICY

St. Stephen's Junior School discourages the bringing of mobile phones to school.

However, mobile phones may be brought to school under certain circumstances: -

- Should a child bring a mobile phone into school, it should be handed immediately to the class teacher. Parents need to recognise that under no circumstances will the school accept liability for loss or damage to the phone.
- It should also be accepted that the mobile phone is switched off on entry to the school grounds and not switched on again until your child leaves the school grounds. It should, at no point be used during the school day. This includes its use as a camera or game console and includes any additional hours spent in Breakfast Club or After School Club.
- Should the mobile phone be used during the day without permission from an adult, it will be confiscated and its return will **only** be made directly to parents at the end of the School day.
