RE: Peer mediation training for Years 5 & 6

Dear parents and pupils,

I am pleased to announce that we are able to offer 15 pupils across Year 5 and 6 the opportunity to have some training to become a Peer Mediator. The training will be carried out by external trainers. The costs of the training are being met by school.

What is Peer mediation?

Peer mediation is a way of resolving fall outs between pupils. Mediators help both sides listen to each other and help find a way to sort things out. Mediators never takes sides, they simply try to help others. Peer mediation is important to us as a school and our anti-bullying policy. It helps pupils deal positively with fall outs and helps to prevent a pattern of fall outs which can lead to bullying.

When will the training take place?

The training will take place on Mondays after school from 3-4.30pm starting on Monday 12th November. Pupils who would like to do this training are expected to attend all 6 sessions.

Applying to be a Peer mediator:

Pupils who are interested in the training to become a Peer mediator for the school year will need to complete an application form and return it to me by Friday 12th October 2018. Places are limited and pupils will be informed if they have been successful on Monday 15th October 2018.
