ADMISSIONS POLICY

We are usually able to accommodate most applications but in the event of over subscription the following criteria will be applied:-

- 1. Looked After Children and previously Looked After children.
- 2. Current family association (an older brother or sister in the school at the time of entry) Linked Infant and Junior schools are considered to be the same school for this criterion.
- 3. Attendance at the linked school (St. Stephen's Infant School)
- 4. Medical/Health and special access reasons
- 5. Nearness of children's home
