



PSHE

Maths

We will also be using our number bonds to help us work out some of the calculations using mental maths.

PE

Our focus in PE this term is fitness.

Science

Firstly, we will be learning about the food groups and what a balanced diet is. After, we are studying Rocks. Children begin identifying and grouping rocks based on their simple properties..

RE

We will be learning about Christianity. We are exploring what the true meaning of Christmas is to Christians and we will compare this with what Christmas means to us.



History

We will be learning about the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age in History this term! We are going to learn about what life was like before people could read and write. We aim to work on our historical skills by learning about what chronology means and using artefacts to explore what life was like during pre-history.



English

Our reading lessons will be based around the books "Krindlekrax" and the "Polar Express" Through these texts, we will develop the VIPER skills: widening our vocabulary, making inferences, making predictions, explaining author intentions, retrieving information and summarising. Our writing focus will be on narrative inspired by the book "Star in a Jar" and a letter based on The Polar Express
