



Spelling

Children will be given a spelling list of 10 words each week on Friday, which they will be required to practise at home in preparation for a spelling test on the following Friday before receiving their new list. A paper copy of the spelling list will be sent home every Friday. We will also post the list on Class Dojo.

Reading

Accelerated Reader (AR) is a computer program that helps teachers to manage and monitor children's independent reading practice. It has been a very successful programme that we have been using at St Stephen's for a while now. It encourages a love of reading, allows children to access a variety of texts and ensures the children understand what they are reading with a small follow up quiz. You can quiz in school or at home. In Year 3, the children are required to read for at least 10 minutes each day. Your child will be allocated an appropriate reading book, which they will bring home each day. We also ask that you document what the children have read in their reading diary. We check the reading diaries once a week.

Times Tables

We will begin by consolidating our knowledge of the 2's, 5's and 10's times tables. We will focus on a times table each week and complete a small test on a Monday and Friday. This is 5 minutes and tests multiplication facts only. If your child has mastered their multiplication facts, there are extra levels of challenge to deepen their learning and promote maths mastery. We will let you know our times tables focus for the week on Class Dojo. Each term, we complete a times tables check that tests all tables up to 12. If you would like to know the results of the times tables check in more detail, please ask your class teacher. Please continue to practise and learn times tables using whichever method suits you most. We encourage children to use Times Tables Rockstars. If you have not received a log in, please ask your class teacher.

Reminders

Equipment: children should have equipment to support their learning. This includes: pencil, pencil sharpener, ruler and glue stick. Please name items.

Water bottles: Please make sure your child comes to school each day with a water bottle.

Uniform: Please name items of clothing. The correct school uniform should be worn every day. Hoodies and jumpers with slogans are not part of our school uniform. Please go to the Office if you need anything.
