Reading

Although reading time is built into our school day, we do encourage all children to read regularly at home, ideally sharing this reading with an adult. We have timetabled library slots so that children can change reading books regularly, but we do ask that they complete an AR quiz after each book where possible. Please encourage your child to read as often as possible, and to bring their reading records to school each day.

Spelling

This term, spelling lessons and tests will take place on a **Thursday**. A list of words will be sent home, following a lesson in which the words have been specifically taught with a focus on the pattern that week. We have some practice time for these words built into our week, but it is also important to encourage the children to practice at home. Paper spelling lists are provided, and a list of class spellings will be posted on dojo each week.

Times Tables

In year 4, we teach times tables regularly, within maths lessons and as a separate activity. Your child will have a specific tables focus that they practice throughout the week, and have a test on a Friday. All children will use Times Tables Rockstars in school to support their learning, but please do encourage them to use this site frequently to continue their practise at home.
