



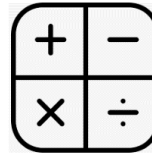
PSHE

This term we think about “**Celebrating Difference**.” We will consider how we are all unique and special. We consider how important it is not to judge by appearance, and we learn more about what bullying is and how to deal with it.



Maths

We will develop our calculation strategies for addition and subtraction, applying these to problem solving and reasoning questions. We will also be developing skills with multiplication and division calculations this term.



Science

This term we are exploring “States of Matter” There will be opportunities to make observations about solids, liquids and gases and how we can change a material’s state through heating or cooling. We will also learn about the Water Cycle.



Computing

This term we will develop **programming** skills using **Scratch**. We will learn important vocabulary, and key concepts, through the creation of a racing game, a band, and a quiz.



PE

In PE every Wednesday, we will be building football skills and developing team work through games. On **Mondays this term, we have our Forest school** sessions. Please come prepared, whatever the weather!

Spanish

This term we will learn 10 common vegetables, and the language needed to role play buying different quantities of these from a market stall.

RE

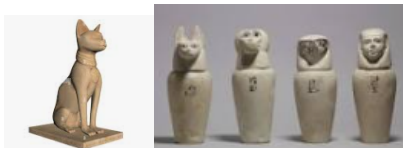
Through our lessons this term, we will be exploring the question “What is the most significant part of the Nativity story to Christians today?”

Music

This term we will focus on rhythm, and playing musical instruments, such as the glockenspiel, in time with music.

Art

After learning about the cultural impact of animals in Ancient Egypt, we will explore features of sculptures before we design and make our own sculptures around this theme.



English

Our reading lessons continue to be based around the book, “The Girl who stole an Elephant.” whilst we further develop our **VIPER** skills through a variety of extract lessons. Our writing will begin with a narrative inspired by the wonderful picture book “Float.” We will then be looking at how to use our letter writing skills to write persuasive letters.



History

We will continue learning about **Ancient Egypt** in History this term. We will learn more about how Ancient Egyptians lived, what they believed in, and how Pharaohs were mummified!
