# **Computing**

The children will learn about the order of operations and understand the importance of completing calculations in the correct order.

#### **English**


We will explore 3 different genres of writing this term. The first will be a formal, persuasive letter that will require the children to consider their audience carefully. We will also write a personal letter from the point of view of an evacuee during World War 2 which will use our history learning. We will end the term with a narrative that focuses on dialogue.

We will continue with our Class Text of 'Our Castle by the Sea'. The children are excited to find out what happens next!

We will use our Extract Reading lessons to continue exploring a range of texts, including song lyrics, novels and adverts.

#### Science

This term's topic is electricity. The children will build upon their prior learning of circuits to draw and make their own. The children will use their knowledge to predict if a circuit will work and explain the reasoning.

Our focus religion will be Christiantiy. Our big question is: Do Christmas traditions help Christians understand who Jesus was



### **History**

Our World War 2 day introduced concepts such as rationing and the role of women in WWII. We will explore these in further detail in term 2. We will introduce Operation Dynamo and understand the role Dover Castle played during this.
