



Welcome to Year 3 !

It has been delightful to welcome your children in to our school. The children have settled well and have thoroughly enjoyed getting to know their new classmates, teachers and teaching assistants. We will be completing a host of exciting learning this term! We have provided an overview of what to expect!

Reading

In Year 3, the children are required to read for at least 10 minutes each day. Your child will be allocated an appropriate reading book, which they will bring home each day. Your child should have a school reading book by the end of next week. If you have not given consent for the Accelerated Reader programme, the class teacher will be in touch to ask for your permission.

Spelling

Children will be given a spelling list of 10 words each week on Friday, which they will be required to practise at home in preparation for a spelling test on the following Friday before receiving their new list. A paper copy of the spelling list will be sent home every Friday.

Homework – Times Tables

We will begin by consolidating our knowledge of the 2's, 5's and 10's times tables. At the end of Year 4 children are assessed on their times tables up to 12x. Please continue to practise and learn times tables using whichever method suits you most. We encourage children to use Times Tables Rockstars. You will receive a log in by the end of the week.

Reminders

Equipment: children should have equipment to support their learning. This includes: pencil, pencil sharpener, ruler and glue stick. Please name items.

Water bottles: Please make sure your child comes to school each day with a water bottle.

Uniform: Please name items of clothing. The correct school uniform should be worn every day. Hoodies and jumpers with slogans are not part of our school uniform. Please go to the Office if you need anything.

Days to remember:

Please send your child into school in their forest school kit. Children will need to bring their school clothes in a bag on Monday so they can change if they get muddy.
