



# Year 4 Curriculum Term 5

## English

Our class text this term will be "The Land of Roar." Through this, and a variety of other reading extracts, we will continue to develop the **VIPERS** skills. Our writing will begin with non-fiction linked with science. We will then be writing another narrative, using the novel "Charlie and the Chocolate Factory" as our stimulus.



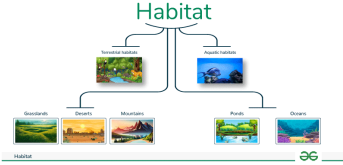
## Maths

This term we will spend a few weeks exploring decimal numbers; using place value charts and number lines to become familiar with tenths and hundredths. We will then be building on our prior learning about money and time.



## Science

This term we will be exploring living things, and their habitats. We will use classification keys to sort plants and animals, and look at the impact that humans have on different habitats.



## Computing

We will continue to explore power point with animation this term and then focus on internet research linked with our science learning. It will be an opportunity to review our understanding of digital literacy: using the internet safely and responsibly.

## PE

Lessons will continue on Wednesdays each week, with rounders skills being developed. **Forest School** will replace PE on **Mondays** this term so please remember to wear old clothes and have a change of shoes.

## Spanish

This term we will continue to practise introducing ourselves in Spanish. We will then learn the names of some classroom items.

## RE

As we revisit Judaism this term, we focus on the key question, "What is the best way for a Jew to show commitment to God?"



## DT

We have an exciting textiles unit this term, focussing on investigating, designing, making and evaluating money containers. This will involve learning some different sewing techniques, and of course being able to thread a needle!



## PSHE

This term we think about "Relationships" We will continue talking about friendships and how to solve difficulties. We will then learn about other types of relationships; how we can show respect, and how to cope with our feelings.

## MUSIC

This term we will be exploring music from the early rock era. We will listen and appraise, and work together to create our own compositions.

## Geography

This term we will be learning about Antarctica. We will use atlases, and understand the significance of lines of latitude and longitude. We will explore the physical features of Antarctica and what life can be found there.
