Reading

We would love to see a big increase in quiz completion.

Homework

We will continue to have a spelling test every Monday. The other homework task will be taken from the CGP Grammar and Punctuation book. Please look out for messages on Classdojo to make sure your child is completing the correct task. Homework is an important way for children to prepare for secondary school, when the expectations will be even higher.

Times Tables

Please continue to regularly practise times tables with your child. Strong times table knowledge is a solid foundation of all maths knowledge, so they are vital. As a school, we use Times Tables Rockstars as an online resource to practise times tables. Please let us know if your child has lost their login details; we can send them out again.

Reminders

<u>Equipment:</u> Please can we ask all children to come to school whenever possible, with a pencil case containing: Black handwriting pen, Pencil, sharpener, Ruler, Purple pen, and a Glue stick. They may also choose to bring colouring pens/pencils. Please check that your child has all the stationery they require to access their learning. Some items can be purchased from the office.

<u>PE days:</u> Our P.E days are Thursdays and Fridays. Please send children into school in their P.E kits on these days. Leopards will need swimming kit on Tuesdays and PE kit on Thursdays; they will not have PE on Friday.
