Curriculum
Term 6

Maths

Maths this term will focus on consolidating KS2 learning to prepare for secondary school. The lessons will be taught through a mixture of arithmetic lessons and tests as well as projects that put mathematics into a real life context.

English

This term we will be writing a narrative that focuses on building a mysterious atmosphere. There will be opportunities to explore additional genres during the last few weeks such as writing a review and a letter to our future selves.

Reading

Children will look at extracts linking to the wider curriculum whilst also enjoying the new class text: The Mystery of the Night Watchers.

Art

The topic this term is LANDSCAPES. Children will experiment with different mediums and techniques to make their own art of local landscapes. We will make links to famous and local artists.

PE

A range of activities will be completed this term:

- Sports Day Preparation
- Rounders
- Dance within production rehearsals

The children are excited to be able to complete sports on the field.

Science

The science learning this term will continue to look at inheritance, adaptation and variation. The next topic will be 'fossils' which builds upon their Year 3 learning. To end the year there will be some consolidation lessons and projects.

Forest School

Each Monday, **from week 2**, the children will be attending Forest School. In the first session, the children were given the opportunity to choose activities they would like to complete.



PSHE

The unit is called: Changing Me
This focuses on the theme of changes which includes the changes our bodies go through. A letter was sent out by Mr Parkin (PSHE lead) about the contents of this topic.

Production

Official rehearsals for our Year 6 production of 'Shrek: The Musical Jr' will begin. Children will be learning the script, learning more songs and learning class dances. In addition to the performance side of the production, children will support with making props and scenery.
